

## Oakridge Pool Rules

- Use common sense in and around the pool. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.**
- **NO GLASS** is allowed in or around the pool.
- **No standard diapers are allowed in the pool. Swim diapers required.**
- Do not use lifesaving or cleaning equipment unless you are doing one or the other.
- Walk; no running is permitted in the pool area.
- Lock the gates. County regulations and Insurance requirements direct that pool enclosure entrance(s) must be locked at all times.
- Children under 14 years of age may not use the pool unless accompanied by an adult.
- Guests: The pool is for the use of all who live here and their guests. Use common sense and reasonably limit the number of your guests. Accompany your guests to the pool.
- Music is limited to personal devices - Please use your headsets while enjoying music at the pool.
- Smoking/tobacco use is not allowed in the pool area.
- Pets are not allowed in the pool or pool area.
- Swimming is prohibited during inclement weather – stay out of the water during thunderstorms for obvious reasons.
- The pool may not be reserved for the exclusive use of one group.
- Clean up after yourself. Replace furniture to its original position and use the trash cans.
- Pool cleaning: stay out of the pool when it is being cleaned.
- Pool hours are: **Dawn to Dusk**. Exercise some discretion especially after 6:00PM; some of your neighbors live quite near the pool. As a courtesy, please make sure restrooms are closed and the lights have been turned off before leaving the pool area late in the day.
- Solitary swimming is prohibited – always swim with a buddy.
- Disruptive members or guests will be asked to leave and, in extreme situations, denied pool privileges at the sole discretion of the HOA Board.
